

**CLAREMONT WOMEN'S GOLF CLUB FIRST AMENDMENT TO
AMENDED RESTATED BY-LAWS dated September 13, 2019**

ARTICLE I - PURPOSE

Section I: This Amendment is pursuant to requests made by previous residents/members for membership.

ARTICLE II - DISCUSSION AND METHODOLOGY


Section 1: Because of the restrictions imposed by Covid-19, the Board discussed the issue via e-mail.

Section 2: The majority of the Board members decided it would be to the advantage of the Club to permit former resident/members who have moved from Claremont to become associate members with certain restrictions, to wit:

- A. Associate members may participate in the regular Tuesday games and in the Member/Guest tournament if invited to do so.
- B. Associate members may not participate in the Club championship.
- C. Associate members may not hold office in the Club, vote as a regular member, or serve on the Board..
- D. Associate member will pay \$65 for membership, which will include USGA GHIN handicap service by the Oregon Golf Association and membership in the Pacific Northwest Golf Association and subscription to the Pacific Northwest Golf Magazine.

Section 3: Pursuant to the provisions of the By-Laws this amendment was presented to the current membership for approval. Because of the requirements imposed by Covid-19, it was presented electronically. A positive response was received by more than two-thirds of those responding

THEREFORE, this Amendment to the Amended By-Laws was approved by the membership of the Claremont Women's Golf Club on the 31st day of January, 2021.

**CLAREMONT WOMEN'S GOLF CLUB SECOND AMENDMENT TO
AMENDED RESTATED BY-LAWS dated September 13, 2019**

ARTICLE I - PURPOSE

Section I: The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate the inconsistency occurring between the provisions of Article VI, Section 1 and Article IX, Section 4 of the Amended Restated By-Laws.

ARTICLE II - DISCUSSION AND METHODOLOGY

Section 1: This Amendment was referred to the Executive Board for study and the Board did recommend adoption or rejection at the next meeting of the Membership.

Section 2: Pursuant to the provisions of the By-Laws this Amendment was presented to the current membership for approval thirty days prior to voting. A positive response was received by more than two-thirds of those responding at the General Meeting on October 5, 2021.

THEREFORE, Article VI, Section 1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Meetings of this Club shall be held on Opening Day, the first Tuesday of June and of September, and on Closing Day”.
